## Description of ISOT

The Islamic Society of Tracy (ISOT) is a federally registered non-profit organization under Section 501 (C) (3) Internal Revenue Code. Located in the City of Tracy, it is an independent organization and does not have any affiliation or association with any other political or non-political organizations, parties, institutes, or establishments.

The ISOT has a board of directors, which consists of 13 members. The board members are elected every two years by members of this organization. The board of directors manages, organizes, and conducts day-to-day activities of the masjid and its Islamic school.

Two Friday Prayers as well as five daily prayers are performed at masjid in congregations. These gatherings give our community members a chance to meet with each other and exchange ideas on how to promote, maintain, and preserve our shared Islamic beliefs, attitudes, values, tradition, and heritage which characterize us.

The ISOT offers classes in teaching our members and their children the Holy Quran, Fiqh, Language, history, and Islamic studies. We also have Friday Night Family programs which bring Muslim families closer in this area. We invite excellent speakers to discuss selected Islamic subjects in detail.

## Challenges of ISOT

Our Muslim community grew very fast since the establishment of ISOT in February of 2000. The number of Muslims in this area has increased from about 1,000 in the year 2000 to about 10,000 in 2023 which makes about 10% of the population of the city of Tracy.

The existing masjid can no longer accommodate all people who come for prayers on Fridays and for Eid prayers. We need to expand our masjid and for doing so, we need the help of our Muslim brothers and sisters.

The respected members of the ISOT (Afghan Immigrants) as well as other Muslim brothers and sisters from outside of the Tracy area helped us in the construction of the building and parking lot of this masjid. Now, it is our moral obligation, responsibility, and duty of all of us to participate in the expansion of this masjid so we can accommodate people who come for prayers.

The ISOT needs your generous support to achieve its goals in continuing serving the Muslim community in Tracy and surrounding areas.

Your help is much needed and appreciated. You will receive Allah's blessings, rewards, and deep-down satisfaction by participating and helping such a worthy and genuine cause. ## Background of ISOT

The Islamic Society of Tracy (Imam Bukhari Masjid), previously known as Afghan Islamic Center, was originally established in February of 2000 at a rental facility located at 503 W Larch Road in the City of Tracy by the Afghan Immigrants of the cities of Tracy and Manteca.

In 2008, the ISOT acquired a property at its current location, 350 N Corral Hollow Road in Tracy. The construction of the building and parking lot were completed in 2010 and 2011 respectively. This masjid is the first masjid in Tracy that has been in service since July of 2011.

The ISOT has welcomed all Muslims of this area, regardless of their ethnic background, color, race, language, age, disabilities, or nationalities, to participate in the day-to-day services and activities of the Masjid.

The ISOT has accepted and will accept the unconditional assistance of other Islamic organizations, Muslim brothers, and Muslim sisters to achieve its vision and missions.
